

## **Clinical Research Coordinator / Study Coordinator**

A Clinical Research Coordinator also known as Study Coordinator is a specialized professional who manages the daily operations of a clinical trial under the supervision of the Principal Investigator. The responsibilities of a Clinical Research Coordinator vary by institution and depend on the tasks delegated by the Investigator. The Clinical Research Coordinator acts as the primary contact for study participants and works closely with the Investigator and other involved departments to ensure that clinical research activities are conducted in compliance with the protocol, Standard Operating Procedures and applicable regulatory requirements.

Thus, the Clinical Research Coordinator serves as a critical liaison between the sponsor and the investigator, playing an indispensable role in the successful conduct and coordination of the clinical trial.
